## Termination of transfer agreements with the Designdins Pension Plan

February 20, 2008

At a meeting held on December 11, 2007, the Fédération Board of Directors agreed to terminate transfer agreements between employers who do not have a direct connection with Desjardins Group and the Desjardins Group Pension Plan. This decision was made for the following reasons:

- Experience shows that it is difficult to establish such agreements with the major employers in the banking sector.
- In the course of the next few years, Desjardins Group will be facing increasingly strong competition in terms of manpower; this means that Desjardins must devote all its efforts to retaining experienced personnel.

Despite this decision, the Desjardins Group Pension Plan will continue to accept individual transfers from other retirement plans.

On January 25, 2008, all managers of the retirement plans affected were officially informed of this decision. However, before definitively terminating the agreements, the clause that defines how either of the parties may do so must be respected. As well, any transfer request received before the termination date of an agreement between the two parties will be deemed valid and processed according to the terms of the agreement concerned, except for those identified with an asterisk in the table below, which may be terminated upon receipt of the notice by the respondent, if that person so desires, or at the latest on the termination date shown.
