He then took a strategic role at Université Laval, where he spent 5 years as an assistant to the vice-rector of human resources and worked on pension plans, investment committees and group insurance.

François has a bachelor's degree in actuarial science from Université Laval and has been a Fellow of the Society of Actuaries (FSA) and a Fellow of the Canadian Institute of Actuaries (FCIA) since 1996.

He is deeply involved in his field and has served on the boards of the Association of Canadian Pension Management and the Pension Investment Association of Canada. He also sits on a number of retirement committees, including one for the professional staff at Université Laval and another for employees and managers in Quebec City's municipal government.
