Financial position

The North American economy showed signs of weakness over the last quarter. Amid softening labour markets and persistent trade tensions, the central banks of Canada and the US both lowered their key interest rates. Even with the rate cuts, inflation stayed above long-term target levels, and future monetary policy decisions will hinge on incoming economic data

In the US, uncertainty intensified as a result of the government's budget impasse, for which there is no clear resolution in sight. Still, major stock markets performed well, buoyed by expectations of further rate cuts, the rise of artificial intelligence and strong corporate earnings. In Canada, long-term bond yields remained stable, reflecting investor confidence.

The financial health of the Desjardins Group Pension Plan (DGPP) remained strong throughout the quarter. The Plan's funding ratio reached nearly 123%, underscoring its ability to meet its long-term commitments. Its solvency ratio increased to 108%, confirming its ability to meet obligations if its assets need to be sold off.
